








About the following report:

- Shows top 10 QSO makers in every CA county.
- Stations who did **not** submit a log **are** also included in this report.
- Report is sorted by # of callsigns active in a given county (from one callsign active to >10 callsigns active).

Suggested actions for operators in CQP 2026:

1. Find the top 10 rarest counties from 2025 and activate one of them in 2026.
2. Find a county that needs more help on a certain mode and activate that mode in 2026.
3. Find a county that was safe in 2025 but which could be at risk in 2026. Activity usually changes year over year from expeditions and fixed stations.
4. Find a county in which just one callsign carried 80+% of the QSO load and operate from that county in 2026.
5. Contact a fixed station owner shown in the report below and offer to be a guest operator in 2026.
6. Read CQP Chair notes for ideas in each county.
7. Just one station in any county can have a huge impact on the entire contest. Please be that station in CQP 2026!

CQP Chair comments: Modoc County has been fully reliant on extremely motivated Oregon residents (K4XU and team) to activate it by expedition over the past many years. What this team has done year after year from Modoc County is simply incredible. Modoc County is the 3rd least populated county in California, yet the county is so well represented by the K6M team that few even know that statistic. However, we shouldn't expect this to run last forever. We need to think seriously about how to adequately cover this county if this outstanding Oregon group is unable to cover Modoc in the future.

CQP Chair comments: Trinity County is the 5th least populated county in CA. Gorgeous surroundings with vast USFS and BLM land make this county prime for expeditions. The presence of a few Airbnbs also helps with expedition possibilities. Mobiles are unlikely to be successful due to mountainous terrain surrounding the main highways. Expeditions by N6DVS, K6KS, KM6BDN and friends have been vital the last five years in Trinity County. We need to do everything we can to support them so that they continue to activate this county by expedition.

<p>CQP Chair comments: Imperial County has been activated in CQP by expedition for as long as I can remember. For many years, the K6QK expedition team (N7CW, K6ZH, N6ERD and N6EEG) has been the primary force in the county. This team is much like the Modoc County expedition team: motivated, reliable, well-equipped and great contesters who make a lot of QSOs. They are also similar in that we cannot expect this to last forever. In 2025, the W6W expedition team operated from IMPE, a very welcome addition to the county. We hope they will operate from IMPE every year. Finally, fixed stations are an untapped resource in this county. A motivated contestor should propose a partnership with KM6NUY and the Imperial Valley Amateur Radio Group club station, or with fixed stations KN6OJX, N6RNN or KA6ASF. Remote partnership opportunities?</p>

CQP Chair comments: Colusa County is similar to Glenn County with respect to geography, area and low population. The geography in the eastern part of the county is conducive for mobile success. Mobiles in Colusa County made up 42% of the county's total QSOs in CQP 2025. This is the highest percentage made by mobiles of CA county. Meanwhile, the terrain in the western part of the county provides opportunities for expeditions on USFS land. AF6TF and AK6JN were successful on their expeditions in CQP 2025 and we hope they return in 2026.

CQP Chair comments: In 2025, Madera County had its best year of CQP coverage in recent memory. Why? WO4O flew from FL to operate from the K6MYC fixed station, and NZ6Q and K5SML (N6M) operated expedition style. While their strong activity was phenomenal for CQP 2025, a red flag is raised for 2026 and beyond. We can't expect WO4O to fly to CA annually, and NZ6Q and K5SML will probably want to try an expedition to a different county. This leaves Madera County in trouble for 2026. Who will ask K6MYC for an opportunity to guest operate from his station? How can we get fixed stations KN6UDK, KG6BXW, N6LED back in the game for 2026? Who will organize an expedition to MADE?

CQP Chair comments: KE8FT and W6AW have been carrying Yolo County in CQP for several years. They have made at least 90% of all QSOs made in Yolo County during CQP for the last three years in a row. Outstanding work by them, and we hope it continues, but we can't expect this to last forever. We are looking for a fixed station or expedition in YOLO which can serve as a second station to be a long term presence on both modes. A creative partnership between a fixed station and a CW contest operator would be beneficial.

CQP Chair comments: A mix of expeditions, fixed stations and mobiles proved that county coverage can be achieved by part time efforts. All stations operated for 5 hours or less, yet collectively had a positive impact on CQP. This is exactly the mix we need in KING without a full time station. K6EI proved that a Sunday one-day expedition, with less than 4 hours operating time, can be very successful running 100 W with a modest antenna from a public park. We were happy to see W0HJW return to CQP in 2025 to provide SSB coverage, as well as K6IJ activate KING on Saturday and TULA on Sunday.

CQP Chair comments: Yuba County was the rarest county in CQP 2024. This changed in a major way in CQP 2025, thanks to two expeditions. YUBA was the 19th rarest county in CQP 2025, its best standing since 2020. Special thanks go to N9DK and NS8X for traveling several hundred miles round trip to set up and operate CQP from a campground, making over 750 QSOs as N6E. This is a great example of the positive impact that anyone can make from a rare county. What is in store for YUBA in CQP 2026?
